E-Waste:

What do you do with those old Computers, Monitors, Printers, etc.?

It is illegal to dump old computer equipment in the garbage. That ends up in the landfill and leaches lead and other toxic metals into the ground water. It is becoming harder to find schools and charities that will take the old equipment either.

So, how can you legally dispose of this old equipment? Sacramento County has an E-Waste recycling program. They collect these materials at the Kiefer Landfill and North Area Recovery Station. There is a charge per unit dropped off. To find out more, visit www.sacgreenteam.com.
